## MEMORANDUM

**TO:** All Board Supervisors & Staff

**DATE:** January 15, 2004

**RE:** Lexington Oaks CDD

At last month's meeting, questions were raised regarding the transition of the election of Board Supervisors from a Landowners' vote to a residential General Election. This transition process will begin with the General Election scheduled for November 2, 2004. Over the next three general elections (2004, 2006, and 2008), seats will be moved to the General Election ballot based on the transition schedule defined by Chapter 190, Florida Statutes. As of the 2008 election, all seats will be filled from the General Election and not a result of a Landowners' vote. Those seats which are elected from the General Election may be filled only with residents of the community who have been qualified by the Supervisor of Elections based on criteria established by the State of Florida, Division of Elections. Residents seeking candidacy may request information and applications from the Pasco County Supervisor of Elections directly.

Based on information supplied by the Pasco County Supervisor of Elections, please find below, the schedule of the elections for the 2004 and 2006 election years.
